Assignment & Grading Rubric:

\_\_\_\_ (2pts): sign up for a date to present your current event

\_\_\_\_ (2pts): your current event is content specific to your grade level – see above

\_\_\_\_ (2pts): your current event is less than four months old (otherwise I am not considering it a current event)

\_\_\_\_ (3pts): presentation is at least 3 minutes long

\_\_\_\_ (15pts): You need to tell the class what your current event is about and how it relates to your area of study this year in science (2pts). You need to tell the class what happened (2pts), where (2pts), who wrote the article (1pt), which website or newspaper you found the story (1pt), and what affect may this have on the world of science and how can this be applicable to everyday life (4). What did you discover about the current event you are presenting (3pts).

Turn in the following. Your summary with name, #, date at presentation at top right hand corner, rubric, and article (Your summary should be half a page, 12-size, times new roman, double space. Basically, your summary is what you are presenting orally to the class.
